



Country rich in History and Beauty

The village of Wedmore is one of the largest in Somerset and occupies a central position on what the Saxons named "The Isle of Wedmore" between the rivers Axe and Brue.

The Church of St. Marys which since 878 has been associated with King Alfred and Guthram—the Danish soldier and leader, is a dominating

and eye-catching architectural feature which has become well known as "The Cathedral of The Moors".

All the country around the village is full of historical interest and legend, and the beauties of the Mendip, Polden and Quantock Hills should be visited.

It is very close to the Cheddar Valley and the Vale of Avalon, Athelney (where Alfred burnt the cakes) and Sedgemoor.

Not far distant is Taunton Vale (with memories of the Monmouth Rebellion and the Bloody Assize).
